You are cordially invited to join the LVC symphony orchestra, led by Dr. Johannes Dietrich, associate professor of music, as they travel to Austria and the Czech Republic. This trip, organized by the tour company Music Celebrations International, will depart in May 2006 for a twelve-day tour. The cost is \$3,000 per person and includes air transportation from Philadelphia to Munich and a bus connection from Munich to Salzburg.
